Air Evac EMS, Inc., which operates Air Evac Lifeteam, is the largest independently owned and operated membership-supported air medical service in the United States, conducting its operations through 103 mutually-supporting air medical bases across 15 states.

The Company operates the world's largest fleet of more than 110 medically-equipped Bell 206 Long Ranger helicopters and has safely flown more than 225,000 people who were in critical need of care since its founding.

The Bell 206 Long Ranger helicopters are rated among the safest, most reliable and agile aircraft in the world. A fleet consisting of one type of aircraft leads to standardized, more efficient training, maintenance, the development of best practices and results in economics of scale that allow for continued re-investment in the fleet.

Air Evac Lifeteam's 50,000-square-foot Completion Center, built in 2006, employs more than 60 aviation professionals proficient in mechanics, avionics, sheet metal fabrication, and aircraft painting, with a deep technical expertise developed over years of specialized experience with the Bell 206 LongRanger helicopter. When AEL purchases a helicopter, each aircraft undergoes a rigorous refurbishment process. The helicopter is stripped down to the skeleton and rebuilt, so it is essentially a new aircraft when it is finally put back into service.

The tour will consist of a visit to the Completion Center, National Dispatch, Membership, Patient Accounts, Accounting/Finance, and other departments/buildings.
